## **IRS Provides Relief for Taxpayers Affected by Ongoing Coronavirus Disease 2019 Pandemic**

With the release of Notice 2020-17, the Internal Revenue Service is providing payment relief on account of the current Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) emergency. The Treasury Department and IRS are extending the due date for Federal income tax payments due April 15, 2020, to July 15, 2020, for payments due of up to \$10 million for corporations and up to \$1 million for individuals - regardless of filing status – and other unincorporated entities. Associated interest, additions to tax, and penalties for late payment will also be suspended until July 15, 2020.

Notice 2020-17 will be in IRB 2020-15, dated April 6, 2020.
